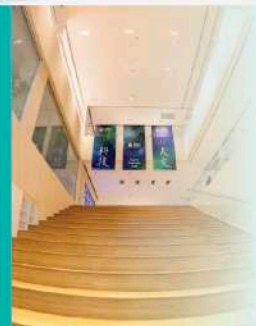
HKU iCube

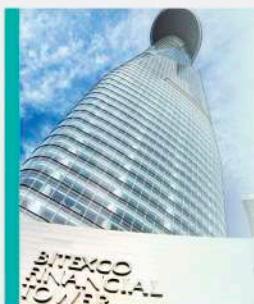
HKU Business School Shenzhen Campus

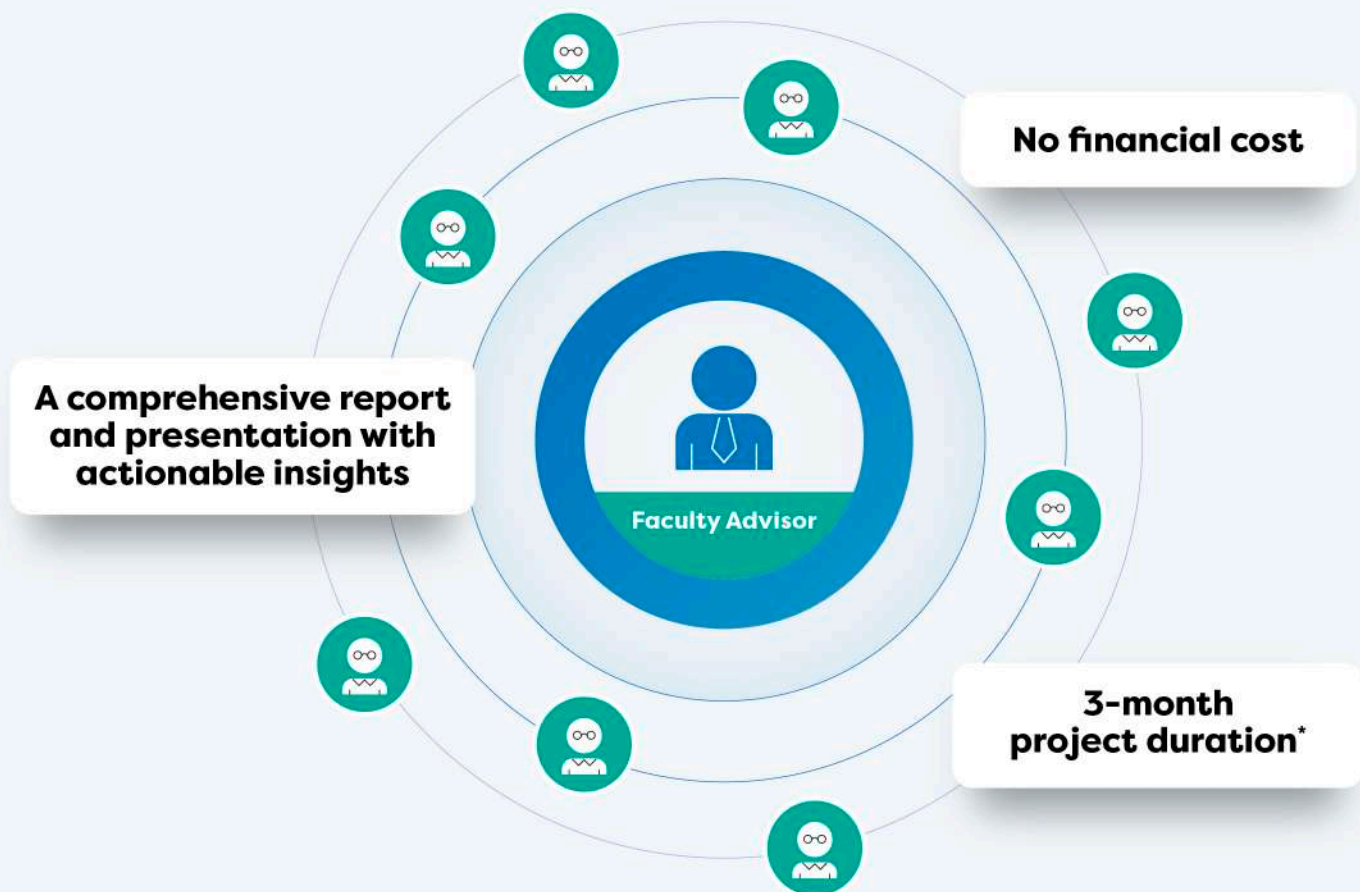

Understanding the Capstone Projects

1 Faculty Advisor + 8 Students



*Capstone projects are commonly 3 months long, but this can be customised based on the agreement between the Project Partner and Faculty Advisor.

Capstone projects, which are credit-bearing and integral to the programme requirements for masters students at HKU Business School, represent a flagship initiative that bridges leading organisations with top talent. These collaborations empower students and partners to co-create practical solutions for real-world business challenges. Through this partnership model, high-quality projects are sourced from diverse stakeholders, ensuring both relevance and impact.

Each capstone project team is composed of eight masters students, carefully matched to the project through a structured bidding process that considers students' interests and programme backgrounds. Every project is led by an academic advisor, ensuring strong guidance and quality control throughout the experience. Each project team works intensively on practical problem-solving, delivering

actionable insights and innovative solutions for project partners. The process is streamlined via an online portal for project proposals, matching, and feedback, while a robust quality control system ensures high standards and meaningful outcomes. The normal duration of each project is of three months, but can be customised upon mutual agreement between the Project Partner and the Faculty Advisor. This structure ensures that students have ample time for in-depth problem-solving, stakeholder engagement and the development of impactful solutions.

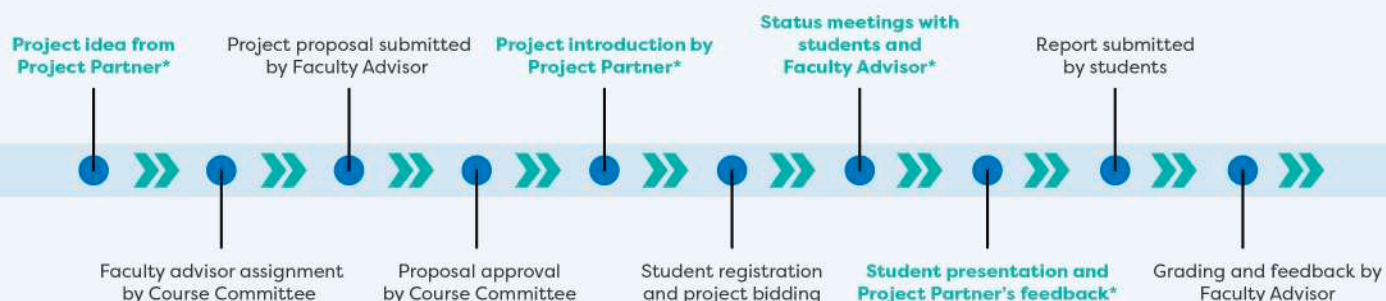

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

What does it cost to be a Project Partner?

Participation is **completely free**. All we ask is your active support on sharing data, giving feedback, and staying engaged to help make the project a success.

How do teams and collaboration work?

Each project team consists of **eight students**, carefully matched to your project's needs. Students may come from **different masters programmes**, selected based on the background knowledge and skills required for your project. Every team is guided by a dedicated **Faculty Advisor from HKU Business School**. Collaboration can be **remote**, **onsite**, or **hybrid**, whatever works best for your organization.

How long does a capstone project last?

Most projects run for three months, but the timeline can be adjusted to suit your needs and the Faculty Advisor's guidance.

What is expected from Project Partners?

Designate a representative to introduce your project, join status meetings, and provide data or feedback. Your involvement helps drive meaningful results.

How do I submit a project idea?

Fill out an **interest form** with your project details. After a Faculty Advisor is assigned, you will work together to finalize the proposal for review.

Can I join more than one project?

Yes, you can participate in up to two projects per masters programme. For popular projects, two teams may work on similar topics if you have the capacity.

Is my project guaranteed to be selected?

Project ideas are reviewed and then chosen by students through a bidding process. Only projects with enough student interest will move forward.

Is data privacy protected?

Yes, all teams and advisors follow strict confidentiality agreements. Sensitive data is managed securely and used only for academic purposes. Non-Disclosure Agreements (NDAs) can be arranged if needed.

What will I receive at the end?

You will get a comprehensive written report and a formal presentation, packed with actionable insights and recommendations.
